The National Institute of Educational Testing Service (Public Organization) set up the O-Net test for all students so schools can measure academic ability and use it to improve teaching and studying. The test results are used as one of the factors for graduation from the 2008 Basic Education Core Curriculum. This year, the National Institute of Education Testing Service will hold the test on **Saturday 31st January and Sunday 1st February 2015 at 7.30 am - 4 pm at Sarasas Ektra School (Secondary Department)** Rules and regulations for the O-Net test are following:

1. Students must wear school uniform on the test day.
2. Students should arrive school at 7.30 am and report to teachers at Crescent Court 2. Moving to the test room at 8.00am (Students arriving more than 30 min will not be permitted to go to the test room)
3. Students must bring a 2B pencil, an eraser, a sharpener and a pen on the test day.
4. Only these things can be brought into the test room. No pencil case, No cell phones or anything else is allowed in the test room.
5. Students need to bring current National I.D or Student I.D card that has a photo or the government issued card that that is not expired to show to teachers before entering the test room.
6. School will prepare morning drink, lunch, and snack for all students on the test day.
7. Parents can collect their child after the test has ended.
8. The National Institute of Education Testing Service will announce the test results on 16th March 2015 on the website www.niets.or.th

All Secondary students year 9 **are required** to take an Ordinary National Education Test (O-NET) to use it as one of the factors for graduation, and for students to compare their academic ability. We request parents to please allow their children to take the test on the date and time above.
