Subject: Year 3 National Test Cancelled

Dear parents of Year 3 pupils,

As the Office of Private Education Commission had earlier announced the Ministry of Education’s policy concerning student assessment, which stated that all schools must hold a National Test in order to evaluate the students’ academic aptitude, school had the letters of notification sent to you accordingly.

However, Minister of Education Mr. Teerakiat Jaroensettasin then stipulated a student assessment policy for the academic year 2016 with an emphasis on “formative assessment” as a means of evaluating students’ educational advancement. For this reason, the National Test is no longer valid as a national assessment and has been cancelled as a result.

Therefore, School would like to **announce that the Year 3 National Test, which was programmed to take place on Wednesday, March 8, 2017 as the Minister of Education had earlier notified, has been cancelled.**

Please be informed accordingly. School thanks you for your unflagging cooperation.
