School's traffic department will change the traffic course in school's Primary Department campus (Soi Sathupradit 20). The purpose of this change is to help the traffic inside school flow better and to attempt to reduce air pollution (within school). This new policy will be effective from September 18th, 2017 onwards.

Please take note of the following details.

1. **Before:** when cars were inside school and passing Building 6, parents would keep driving on the right side in order to make a turn to the left side (students used to get off on the right side)

New Policy: after passing Building 6, parents are kindly asked to keep driving on the left side in order to make a turn to the right side (students to get off on the left side)

Reducing Parking Area in order to increase the traffic space
 Traffic Course under Building 6 is still the same (no change).

Furthermore, to relieve the traffic problems and the pollution from the number of vehicles in school, we kindly ask for your cooperation as detailed below.

- 1. Please refrain from parking the car to get school bags or other things from the boot/trunk of your car. Students should have their school bag and any other belongings on their person. This is to help speed up the process when students get out of their cars.
- 2. The parking area size will be reduced. The parking spaces are reserved for parents who need to contact the administration office.
- In the early morning: please help to train the students to walk to their classrooms by themselves.
 If you need to have breakfast at school, after you have finished, please kindly move your car to help share the limited parking spaces with other parents.
- 4. In the afternoon: please come to pick up your child/children at the time school actually ends. If your child/children study on the after school program, please come a little later than the class's finishing time. If you come too early, you might have to keep driving around and around until the class has finished.
 Furthermore, whilst waiting you might still have your engine on and consequently increase the levels of pollution at school. It could also lead to more traffic congestion on the streets around the school and it may waste your time and resources.
- 5. School asks parents to use their indicator signals at all times when wishing to change route and especially when turning left or right.

The change of the traffic course in school may cause some inconvenience in the early stages. School's traffic team would like to take this opportunity to apologise to all parents in advance for any disruption caused. We truly appreciate your understanding and continued cooperation.
