Friday 1st November saw Dr. Laslo Kozma give an in-depth presentation to students and parents interested in available scholarships for the University of Debrecen in Hungary.

The scholarship package includes 100% for

the tuition fees, a monthly spending stipend, a stipend towards accommodation, and, medical insurance. The university has been around since 1538, has 14 faculties on 7 campuses, and over 5,600 international students from over 110 counties.
