- 1. Date and time of the examination: August  $1^{st} 7^{th}$ , 2018 during computer class
- 2. Examination venue Department: Year 4 6 at Computer room, Dominic 1 Bldg., Floor 3, Primary Department

Year 7 - 9 at Computer room, St. John Bosco Bldg., Floor 4, Secondary Department

Year 10 – 12 at Computer room, St. John Baptist Bldg., Floor 3, Secondary Department

3. Examination: Year 4 – 6: Oxford Young Learners Placement Test

Year 7 – 12 : Cambridge English Placement Test

- 4. Materials to bring: Each student needs to bring a set of headphone (any kind) to be used in the listening part of the examination
- 5. Charge: Students do not have to pay any fees for the test. In cases where any students are absent in the specified examination periods, parents are liable for the examination fee at a rate of 150 Baht per student for Year 4-6 and 300 Baht per student for Year 7-12 (except for cases where students are sick or have been in an accident and needs to be hospitalized, or if students have travelled abroad or upcountry. Parents are kindly requested to provide evidence to prove that the trip was planned before the issue of this letter).
- 6. Students should not be absent during the examination period(s) because the school will not receive the examination result and therefore we will not have complete and accurate data from the abovementioned tests. School is keen to ensure that we have complete results to be able to accurately input new strategies to improve English teaching and methodology.
- 7. The examination result will be under the school's possession. Parents will not receive students' examination results.
