Timetable Changes for Semester 2 in Y.4 - Y.12

School will slightly alter the timetable for Semester 2 to allow for time to practice for the Christmas shows. The Primary and Secondary Departments will decrease each lesson from 50 minutes to 45 minutes. This will be applicable to Year 4 to 12 only (Year 1 to 3's timetable will remain unchanged). Furthermore, lunch- time will be reduced from 50 minutes to 40 minutes. The accumulated time, in both campuses will be 45 minutes to practice for Christmas shows. The adjustments will last until the end of December 2018. Normal timetables will resume after the New Year.

Asking for school documents

If parents need any school documents for students, they can submit a request at the admin office. It takes about 5-7 days to prepare the documents after the request is submitted. For parents who still have outstanding fees, these must be settled (paid) before collecting the documents.

Leaving Our School

If parents do not wish for their child to continue in Semester 2/2018, they can submit a request at the admin office by the 30th September 2018. Failing to do so will be against the rules and parents will have to pay the amount owing and the Tuition fees for semester 2/2018 in order to receive any school documents. It takes about 5-7 days to prepare the documents

Requesting Visa online

To make it more convenient for our parents, school provides a service for parents to submit a student visa online (VISA Request Letter) through school's website. Please make sure you submit all information correctly and follow all the instructions. After we receive the information, the school will process it within two working days. However, parents with outstanding fee payments will receive the document within 7 working days. Only after all outstanding fees have been paid may parents collect the visa letter.

(If parents make a payment by cheque, parents will receive the requested document(s) seven working days after the payment.)



Simple steps to take care of your health during rainy season

During the rainy season, many students get sick such as catching a fever, coughing, and having sore throat. Some days, we also experience big storms, heavy rain, and hot and humid weather. So, we are going to recommend some tips for taking care of your health so that everyone stays healthy during final exam season. Try these tips below

- 1. Have an umbrella, a raincoat, and a towel on your person at all times. In cases where you need to run through rain, you can use your umbrella or raincoat to protect yourself. If any body parts get wet, use your towel to dry them.
- 2. Avoid wading through water. If you need to, wear boots every time. If boots are not available, it is ok to wade through water. However, wash your feet immediately with water and soap, and completely dry your feet. This is because the water you wade through is not clean.
- 3. If you cough, use tissue paper to cover your mouth instead of using your hand. Alternatively, use a hygienic mask to prevent germs spreading to our hands and to other people.
- 4. Eat nutritious and hygienic food such as food that is cooked well. Most importantly, don't forget to wash your hands before eating
- 5. Protect yourself from mosquitoes. If needed, apply mosquito repellant lotion or lemongrass spray to prevent mosquitoes. This could be another way for you to prevent and reduce the risk of catching dengue fever.
