Small children are really naive, aren't they?



Parents may think that small children are naive but their mood and their minds can be easily be influenced. When they are exposed to certain TV dramas or movies, which are not child friendly or appropriate or witness stressful situations these experiences can have a negative effect on them.

According to the study from the American Academy of Pediatrics the violence seen on TV and through other media outlets has increased and has had a negative influence on children which includes fear, anxiety, suspicion, insomnia, nightmares, depression and concurringly tend to show violence or anger to problems or issues that may arise in everyday life. Furthermore, exposure to various media where sexual behavior is displayed (which also includes inappropriate sexual language) increases the chances for children to imitate the sexual behavior and use the bad language at school and with their friends.

Parents should be aware of the use of their child's exposure to Media, whether this is via TV screen or other electronic devices. The best method is to sit and watch with the child and avoid letting children use Media independently, especially young children because the media may have hidden content, which might include violence, or things that are not suitable for them. Parents should give suggestions and provide understanding rather than just blocking. Parents should look after your children closely and control the usage time of the television, smart phones and tablets in order to practice basic discipline and focus on the positives of using media.
