## Requesting Visas online

To make it more convenient for our parents, school provides a service for parents to submit a student visa online (VISA Request Letter) through school's website. Please make sure you submit all information correctly and follow all the instructions. After we receive the information, the school will process it within two working days.

However, parents with outstanding fee payments will receive the document within 7 working days. Only after all outstanding fees have been paid may parents collect the visa letter



## Leaving Our School

If parents do not wish their child to continue in Semester 2/2019, they can submit a request at the admin office by the **30<sup>th</sup> September 2019**. Failing to do so will be against the rules and parents will have to pay the amount owing and the Tuition fees for semester 2/2019 in order to receive any school documents. It takes about 5-7 days to prepare the documents

## Asking for school documents

If parents need any school documents for students, they can submit a request at the admin office. It takes about 5-7 days to prepare the documents after the request is submitted. For parents who still have outstanding fees, these must be settled (paid) before collecting the documents. (If parents make a payment by cheque, parents will receive the requested document(s) seven working days after the payment.)



## Timetable Changes for Semester 2 in Y.5 - Y.12



In semester 2/2019, the school will make some slight adjustments to the timetable to facilitate students' Christmas Show practice. After the Christmas show period and practise period, classes will go back to regular timetable patterns.

The school will explain this to parents in detail when semester 2 opens.



## After School Classes in Semester 2

After school classes in Semester 2 will start on the first day when school opens, which falls on Monday October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

Parents can make a payment for November's after school tuition fees in advance from now until October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to ensure the seat is held.

In case cancellation's required or afterschool tutorial change is needed for November 2019/ parents' should contact for cancellation or changing, please contact administration offices within the 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019. Changes and cancellation cannot be made if contact is made later than the specified date.
