#### 5. School uniform selling

## 6. Identity verification in School Bright Application

The School Bright system has the highest security updated in the system as follows:

## 7. Measures to prevent COVID in academic year 2023

The situation of Coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) in Thailand is moving in the right direction. There are fewer children with severe symptoms since the announcement of communicable disease surveillance in October 2022.

### In Semester 1/2023, the school has guidelines that suit the current situation as follows:

- 1. Arrange the classroom to be well ventilated. There is a schedule to turn on and turn off the air conditioner to ventilate. Disinfectant will be provided as well as adequate hand washing stations.
- 2. If the infection is found or notified, the class teacher will publicize in the group line for protection information.

## Guidelines for students

- 1. While in the classroom, wear a hygienic mask at all times, and always wash your hands when touching objects or touch points
- 2. Refrain from sending weekly ATK test result, only when there are at-risk symptoms or close contact with the patient
- 3. In case of COVID-19 infection, take a break or treatment for 5 days or according to the medical certificate
- 4. In case of having a family member infected with COVID-19, if the student has a negative ATK test result, the student can come to class as usual
- 5. When feeling sick with fever, cough, sore throat and runny nose, see the doctor and stay at home until healed.

Students are required to follow the measures strictly. The school would like to thank you for your always continuing co-operate well.
